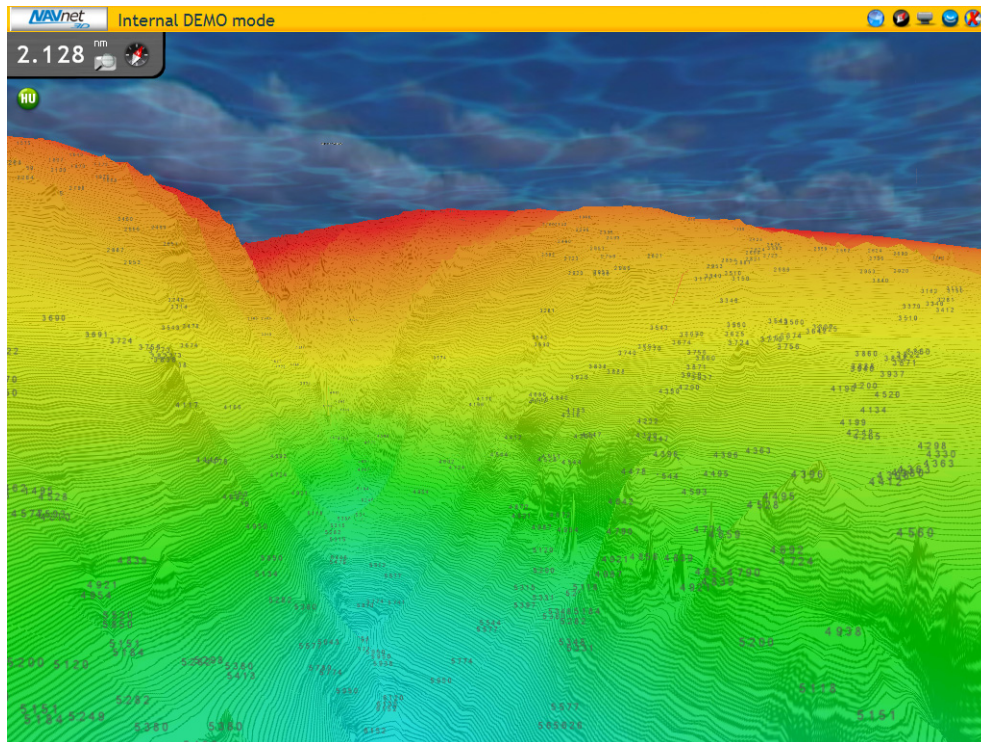
NavNet 3D Offers New High Detail Fishing Charts For U.S. Coastal Areas

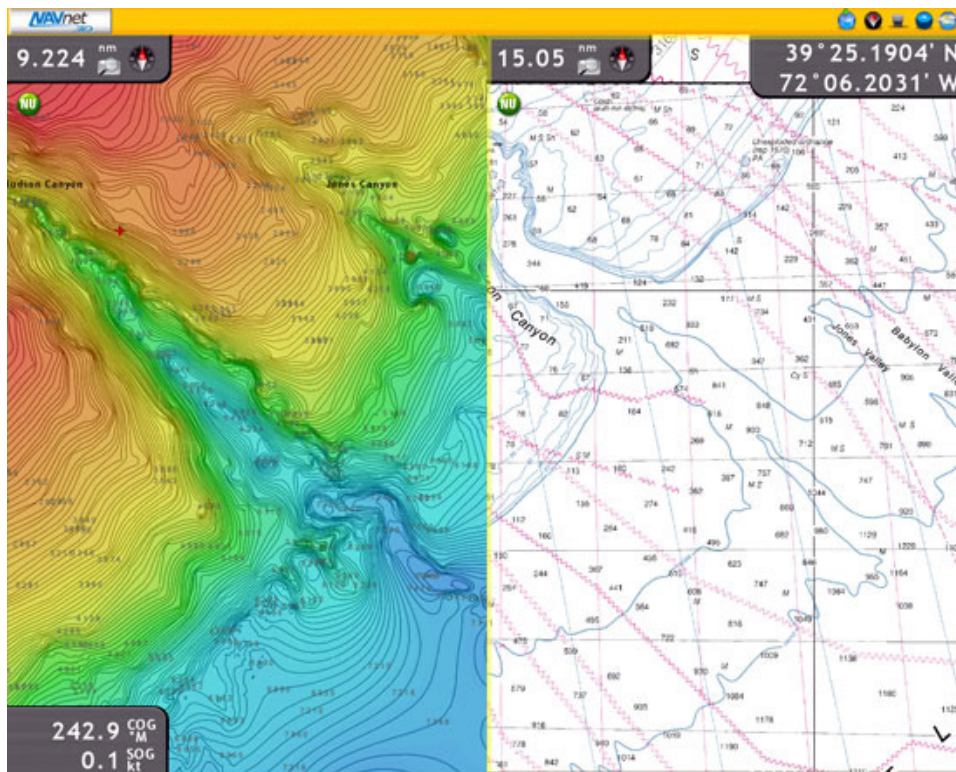

These Fishing Charts cover the main canyons of the East Coast, West Coast and Gulf of Mexico and are rendered in stunning detail on any NavNet 3D MFD (8.4", 12.1" or Black Box).
