

GPS Plotter GP-1600 Operator's Guide

The purpose of this operator's guide is to provide the basic operating procedures for this equipment. For detailed information, refer to the operator's manual.

Changing displays

press ▲ or ▼ (Plotter, Data, Graphic, Highway)

Shifting the display

- Centering own ship

 CURS to turn off cursor → CNTR
- Centering a location
 CURS to turn on cursor → select
 location by cursor → CNTR
- Scrolling the display

 CURS to turn off cursor → Arrow keys
- Enlarging: ZOOM IN
 Shrinking: ZOOM OUT

Stopping/resuming plotting of track

PLOT (H icon indicates plotting stopped.)

Erasing track

MENU → 3 → select "TRACK ERASE" → select "YES" → ENT → ESC

Changing track recording interval

MENU → 2 → select "TIME" or "DIST" on "PLOT INTVL" line → (enter value) → ENT → ESC

Entering marks at cursor location

CURS to turn on cursor → shift cursor
→ MARK

Mark attributes

• Shape/size/line type/tone

MENU → 2 → select attributes to change by Arrow keys → ESC

Erasing marks

Place cursor on mark → CLR



Entering waypoints

Mode selection

$$\boxed{\text{WPT}} \rightarrow \boxed{\text{MENU}} \rightarrow \blacktriangle \text{ or } \blacktriangledown \rightarrow \boxed{\text{ENT}}$$

• At own ship's position

WPT → ENT → change wp no. →
$$\nabla$$
 → ENT (or select mark shape and enter a comment.)

• Through waypoint list

• By cursor

WPT → move cursor → ENT → ENT

(or
$$\nabla$$
 → select a mark → ENT → enter a comment → select "ENTER" → ENT →

ENT)

Setting destination

$$\bigcirc$$
 GOTO \rightarrow \triangle or \bigvee \rightarrow ENT

Mode selection

Cancelling wp navigation:

$$GOTO \rightarrow CLR \rightarrow ENT \rightarrow ESC$$
 twice

Entering routes (max. 20 routes)

Following a route

Mode selection

GOTO → MENU →
$$\blacktriangle$$
 or \blacktriangledown (Route List or Route Plot) → MENU twice

• By cursor-created route


GOTO → place cursor → ENT → more cursor → ENT (twice) →
$$\blacktriangle$$
 or \blacktriangledown to select route no. → ENT

• By route list


GOTO
$$\rightarrow$$
 ▲ or \bigvee \rightarrow TONE (Forward or receive) \rightarrow ENT

MENU → 0 → 7 → select
GEODETIC and OTHER → Enter datum
number referring to page A-1 in operator's
manual. (The default setting is WGS-84.)
