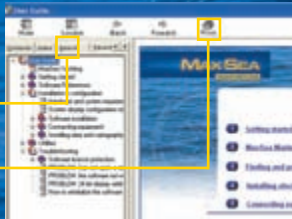


Press F1 for Help

Press the F1 keyboard shortcut or go to the Help menu and choose the User Guide.

Click Search, type the word or phrase to search, then click List Topics.

Select the topic you want to print, and then click Print.



Printing the User Guide

To print the complete User Guide, go to Windows Start menu, Programs, MaxSea utilities and choose "Operator's Manual.pdf" or "Installation's Manual.pdf".

Organizing the Chart Desktop

Right-clicking on each palette title opens a context menu where you can choose display options such as transparency and the size of the buttons and text.



To move each palette, click on its title bar, hold the mouse button down, drag it to the new position and release the mouse button.

Double-click in the title bar of each palette to dock it around the edge of the chart window (top, bottom, right, left).

 Click on the arrow in the title bar of each palette to add or remove buttons as you wish.

 Click on the cross in the title bar of each palette to close it (reopen in Display Menu).

 Click on the bar at the left side of any "docked" palette and drag it to make it a "floating" palette.

The Chart Toolbar

A few clicks is all it takes to display the chart in Auto-centering mode, North Up/Course Up modes and to call up Tide, Current and Weather.

Right-click for more

Quickly access commands or information related to a selected object by positioning the pointer on the object or group of objects and right-clicking.

Zooming Options

1 - Use the Zoom In and Zoom Out Activation Buttons



2 - Use the F2 and F3 keyboard shortcuts or the +/- keys

3 - Use the Magnifying Tool

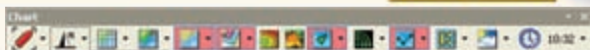
To zoom in : Click and hold while dragging the pointer across the selected chart area, then release to zoom in.

To zoom out: Click and release immediately

4 - Using any Tool, right-click on the chart to select a chart scale



5 - Using a mouse or track ball with a wheel, roll up and down to zoom in and out
